Sub: Guidelines for grant of admission to Class XI in AEC Schools/JCs.

The criterion for admission in class XI from the academic session – 2018-19 is given below.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

a) DAE wards:

There will be no cut-off marks for seeking admission to Class XI in any of the streams available in the AEC Schools/Junior Colleges. The admissions will be done purely on the basis of merit order.

b) Non-DAE wards:

Vacant seats if any in class XI will be offered to the students from Non-DAE categories from I to IV as recommended by the Chairpersons of LMC concerned. The cut-off marks for admission in various streams is as given below:

- i) Admission in Science stream : A minimum of 55% marks in aggregate of Class X
- ii) Admission in Commerce stream : A minimum of 45% marks in aggregate of Class X
- iii) Admission in Humanities stream : A minimum of 40% marks in aggregate of Class X

These guidelines will be effective from the academic year 2018-19.
